After 11 years of existence, Gratitude Trio releases on **September 2nd 2022** its 4th album «**BIRTH**» on the famous Belgian label **W.E.R.F. RECORDS** in partnership with **Mercury** and **Collectif Koa** from Montpellier, France.

Protagonists Jeroen Van Herzeele, Alfred Vilayleck and Louis Favre worked for more than a year on this new album, continuing to develop the musical framework of the previous album: a blend of sensitivity and groove, contemplative vocals and raging solos.

Mixing acoustic and electronic sounds, the compositions reflect realities that inhabit them: to let oneself be touched by the beauty and the dark sides of life, to be amazed by Nature, to accept what we cannot change, to create bonds, to commit ourselves to fulfill ourselves.

A music that is both sophisticated and organic, with an energy and boldness that characterize them. The first single out of this album is the titletrack «BIRTH» and was officially released on **May 20th**. Enjoy this cosmic and spiritual electronic jazz trip.

PRESENTATION

Gratitude Trio is a Belgian/French band based in Brussels known for their strength and sensitivity that opens people's hearts. The music of this power trio is tinged with spacy sounds, african rhythms, sexy grooves, endless trances, sensitive ballads, crazy free jazz and a large dose of unpredictable.

Gratitude exists since 2010 and has performed in prestigious venues in Europe. Their two first albums «**Gratitude**» and «**alive**» released in 2012 and 2015 under the label **el NEGOCITO Records** have been very well received by the critics (Le Soir, De Standaard, Jazzaround) and the enthusiastic audience.

The 3rd album «**Gratitude III**» was released in April 2018: new sound, new approach, but same soul. Gratitude Trio impressed! Indeed, voices and EWI (Electronic Wind Instrument) enrich the sound palette while the musicians have developed a new way to create together.

Thanks to his musician father, Jeroen had the opportunity to play jazz standards on stage at a very young age. After short studies of classical saxophone, he dedicated his life to jazz and started to participate to workshops and seminars, while following courses at the Jazzstudio in Antwerp. Very soon, Jeroen explored other forms of music (freejazz, rock, blues, soul, gospel), clearly present in the recordings of Gratitude Trio. Jeroen has his own sound: intimate, spiritual and instinctive, a sound in tune with his soul. He is constantly trying to perfect jazz language, looking for an initiatory experience, facing the changes of a constantly changing world. He likes to go far in the improvisations carried by urban rhythms without losing the power of his acoustic music, his breath.

- Alfred Vilayleck [electric bass]

At 12, Alfred develops an interest in music through rock and especially Jimi Hendrix. Then, he quickly turns to jazz and improvisations. Graduated from the Perpignan and Strasbourg conservatories, he plays with several jazz bands before founding the Collectif Koa in Montpellier in 2008. He collaborates with Steve Coleman, Aka Moon, Magic Malik, Jim Black. Versatile accompanist and traveller musician, he plays with Serge Lazarévitch, Joël Allouche, Jeroen Van Herzeele, Julien Lourau, John Tchicai, Pierre Van Dormael, Cherif Soumano. Currently, he leads the Grand Ensemble Koa, contributes to several bands such as Gratitude Trio, Peemai, Kunzit and recently the illustrated concert for kids Nefertiti. Alfred teaches jazz at the Conservatoire of Montpellier and also leads many Soundpainting projects.

- Louis Favre [drums]

Louis is a French drummer and composer living in Belgium since he started his music studies at the Lemmens Institute in Leuven in 2003. He holds a Master's degree in Jazz (thanks to the support of Dre Pallemmaerts and Pierre Van Dormael) and a teacher certificate. Before his studies at the Institute, he studied with Serge Lazarévitch and André Mallau at the Conservatory of Perpignan. As an accompanist, he played with great musicians such as Pierre Van Dormael, Ewout Pierreux, Philippe Aerts, Michel Hatzigeorgiou [Aka Moon], Manolo Cabras, Robin Verheyen, Joachim Saerens, Pieterjan Seaux, Steven Delannoye and Tuur Florizoone. He also played for several years with Lokomotiv, a touring band from Leuven led by Jo Zanders with whom he played in many festivals in Europe [Belgium, Portugal, Slovenia, Croatia, Hungary, England, France]. In 2009, he played with Selah Sue for one year and together they composed great hits such as «This world» and «My Direction». He has also served the music of Egon [jazz/soul], Maarten Decombel Trio [folk], DooDooDown [rhythm&blues mixed with improvisation], Roselien Tobbackx [pop]. Since 2009, he accompanies the contemporary dance classes of Humanités-Danse of Louvain-La-Neuve by being an orchestra by himself: drums, keyboard and vocals.

● Gratitude III - 20th April 2018

«**Gratitude III**» is a self-produced album and stands for a great evolution in the band's aesthetics. With self-production, the musicians experiment a great freedom in creation and fully express their sensitivity and groove, so special to Gratitude Trio. The musicians take an other path, integrating electronic sounds, with Jeroen Van Herzeele's EWI and modular synth. The album's inspiration mixes rhythms out of the ordinary such as drum'n'bass, electro pop and ambient music.

● alive - 23rd May 2016 [el NEGOCITO Records]

Their second album «**alive**» is a live recording of new songs alternating between different dynamics and moods; sometimes intense and energetic with grooves and polyrhythms, sometimes more fragile and lyrical, like a ballad full of feelings and emotions. The music gives an energy of letting go, not conceptual or rigid, with a touch of Led Zeppelin. And of course the spirit of Coltrane is never far away.

First eponym album of the power trio, recorded in August 2012, it is a true anthem to John Coltrane spirit, with a touch of Eastern flavours and intense interpretations. The 3 friends, Jeroen Van Herzeele, Louis Favre et Alfred Vilyleck, successively change to groovy tracks, generous ballads and furious contemporary contemplations. An explosive ending, both spiritual and warm.


